Safety Equipment Education and Flare Disposal Day

Learn about required safety equipment, the care and maintenance of that equipment and how to safely and effectively use flares when needed. Bring your outdated marine flares to the address shown below, where you can also purchase new flares. **NOTE: ONLY MARINE FLARES WILL BE ACCEPTED AND ONLY AT THE TIME AND DATE SHOWN BELOW.**

DATE: Saturday July 23rd.

PLACE: Fogh Marine (Etobicoke Store), 901 Oxford Street Toronto ON, M8Z 5T1

TIME: 11 am to 4 pm

In accordance with Transport Canada requirements, flares are approved for four years from the date of manufacture. Typically, this means that you need to replace your flares every third or fourth boating season and dispose of the old ones. If they have expired or will expire during the boating season, you must replace them... it's the law!
